

# Declaration of a Pecuniary Conflict of Interest under the *Municipal Conflict of Interest Act*

The *Municipal Conflict of Interest Act* requires that Council members and members of local boards and committees file written statements of pecuniary conflicts of interest specifying the general nature thereof upon disclosing the conflict of interest. The written statement must be filed upon disclosing the conflict of interest at the meeting or as soon as possible after the meeting.
