**BY-LAW NO. 36-2017**

**Being a by-law to authorize the use of vote by mail and optical scan ballot tabulators for the 2018 Municipal Election**

**WHEREAS** Section 42 of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996* as amended provides that the Council of a municipality may, by by-law authorize the use of voting and vote counting equipment and the use of alternate voting methods that does not require electors to attend at a voting place in order to vote;


**AND WHEREAS** Council gave consideration to alternative voting methods available as set out in an administrative report prepared by the Clerk and presented to Council on April 25, 2017.


**AND WHEREAS** the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Lakeshore considers it desirable to pass such a by-law;



1. **THAT** the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Lakeshore hereby authorizes the use of vote by mail for the purpose of voting and optical scan tabulators for the purposes of counting.
2. **THAT** this by-law shall come into full force and take effect as of the date of its passing.
