## **Pedestrian Bridge Undergoes Repairs**

Lakeshore's Pedestrian Bridge over the Belle River will be closed April 16 for repairs.



The bridge spans the Belle River connecting Lakeview Park to the West Beach. The deck of the bridge is being replaced due to damage. The repair is expected to take 5 days with the bridge reopening April 20<sup>th</sup>.

Individuals can cross the river using the bridge at Notre Dame. The railroad bridge is unsafe and not to be used to cross the river.

Lakeshore's investment in the waterfront park includes a new roof on the splashpad washroom building, new accessible picnic tables with cement pads, deep well garbage receptacles and a new walkable Jetty, ready for summer of 2018.
