Summer Student Employment Opportunities

Deadline for Applications: March 1, 2019 at 2:00 pm

Students who are interested in summer employment with the Town of Lakeshore must apply to the Summer Student Lottery. A listing of available positions and position descriptions are now available on the website. Many of the positions start in May, therefore there are a limited number of positions available for high school students. Students who have been previously employed at the Town and would like to return, must re-apply through the Summer Student Lottery, clearly indicating on the application form that they have been previously employed by the Town as a summer student and in what position. Returning students will be given preference.

Applications are available on our website or pick up at the Municipal Office. Applications must be submitted by 4:00 pm on March 1, 2019 by:

Those students eligible are:

- A resident of Lakeshore
- 16 years of age as of April 30, 2019
- Currently registered or will be registering as a full time student at a secondary school, college or university, on a full time basis, in September 2019

If we receive more applications than the number of positions available, applications will be randomly selected through the lottery. Interviews will be conducted in the order from the lottery based on qualifications for available positions. If you are a student who has worked for the last three summers you will be considered as a new student through the lottery selection process.

Personal information is collected under the authority of the Municipal Act, R.S.O., and in accordance with the Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act and will be used only for the purpose of determining eligibility for this competition.
