## VOTER INFORMATION

### **Can I vote during a Canada Post strike or lockout?**

Yes! Please drop off your completed and sealed Voting Kit at one of the Voting Kit Drop Off Locations listed on the back of this page.

### **Can I vote if a Canada Post strike or lockout is still a possibility?**

Please drop off your completed and sealed Voting Kit at one of the Drop Off Locations listed on the back of this page to ensure that your vote is counted.

### **Can I mail in my completed and sealed Voting Kit if Canada Post and the workers' Union reach an agreement?**

You will have many voting options. You can vote by mail if you mail your completed and sealed Voting Kit before or on October 11 or drop off your completed Voting Kit at one of the Drop Off Locations on the back of this page.

### **Do I have to return my completed Voting Kit to a Drop Off Location in my ward?**

No. You can return your completed Voting Kit to any one of the Drop Off Locations.

### **Can someone else drop off my completed and sealed Voting Kit?**

Yes! Just make sure that the declaration form is signed and sealed in the return envelope, along with the ballot in its secrecy envelope.

### **Will my ballot be counted if I return the Voting Kit without the declaration form?**

No. Please insert your ballot in the white secrecy envelope and seal it. Sign the declaration form and place the signed declaration form and secrecy envelope inside the yellow return envelope and drop off at one of the Drop Off Locations listed on the back of this page.

### **How long will it take me to drop off my Voting Kit?**

Just a few short minutes. You may drop off your completed and sealed Voting Kit at any of the Drop Off locations listed on the back of this page.
