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## **Lakeshore Receives AMCTO Award** for 2024 Budget App

This June, Lakeshore's 2024 Budget Application was recognized by the Association of Municipal Managers, Clerks, and Treasurers of Ontario (AMCTO) for its innovative approach to municipal programs. Lakeshore was presented a Certificate of Merit as part of the E.A. Danby Awards, which recognize and honour municipalities that have "demonstrated outstanding achievement through innovation with respect to municipal management activities or practices."

## **Lakeshore Council Approves New Noise By-law**

On June 11, Council approved the new Noise By-law 16-2024 that reflects the modernized needs of our growing population. This by-law comes into effect on September 1, 2024. Highlights of the changes include:

- Prohibits amplified sound if it's at a volume that disturbs the peace, quiet, comfort, or repose of a person, as determined by an enforcement officer on a reasonable person standard.
- Prohibits unnecessary vehicle noise and sound amplification for advertising in a public place.
- Prohibits persistent animal noise.

Coming up later this summer, Lakeshore will launch a public education campaign about the updated Noise By-law to help residents understand the changes and how the by-law will be enforced. Stay tuned for more information at

### Mayor's Message:

Water and Wastewater Master Plan is Key to Lakeshore's Future

In June, Council and I came together to discuss the Water and Wastewater Master Plan, a document that will guide significant infrastructure investments, protect our residents, and facilitate growth over the next 20 years.

What we know is that there is no easy fix, and the financial burden is significant. The preliminary list of projects, such as water towers, treatment plants, and sewer lines, is valued at over \$260 million. These projects are well-balanced between the eastern and western areas of Lakeshore.

Unfortunately, the cost of these projects is a result of many years of underfunding. While the can has been kicked down the road for decades, we have reached a point where inaction has threatened the health of our residents and the environment.

While these investments may not be flashy or fun, they are

necessary for our success today and where we want to go in the future. It is time to make a decision, and this Council is ready to bear the weight of this critical juncture in Lakeshore's history.

We will look to regional partners, as well as upper levels of government, for support. Much like the federal and provincial governments, we have an interest in making sustainable infrastructure investments to support economic growth and address the housing crisis. This plan will help us achieve those goals, and we will call upon other elected officials to support our efforts.

I look forward to discussing this critical plan, and how we'll fund it, with my fellow members of Council at an upcoming meeting.

### **Planning Applications Now Online**

The Municipality of Lakeshore has been working to migrate all its application processes online. Currently, open burn permits, building permits, and now planning applications can be accessed through Cloudpermit. Through Cloudpermit, residents, stakeholders, and municipal staff can access a user-friendly portal for streamlined application submission, tracking, and management, all in one place.

Online planning applications available online include: Rezonings, Site Plan Approvals, Minor Variances, and Consents.
